### THE FINE ARTS and CRAFTS FESTIVAL

In its ninth year, the Community Arts Center will be moving its annual FESTIVAL of the finest arts and crafts in our area to STATE STREET in MEDIA! With the support of the Media Business Authority, the Borough of Media, Delaware County Council and the Brandywine Conference and Visitors Bureau this new location promises to attract visitors from throughout the tri-state area to an art-filled day in MEDIA featuring great art and craft, fine food and all day fun for the whole family!

**SPECIAL THIS YEAR. . . refer an artist and if accepted, you will BOTH receive a 20% booth fee discount! Here's how it works. . . apply to be a part of the Festival and refer another artist who also applies. If you and the artist you referred are both accepted to exhibit, you both will receive a 20% discount on your booth fee. Spread the word, invite your friends and be part of a new tradition!**

### INFORMATION FOR APPLICANTS

#### Work will be accepted in the following categories:

Drawing and Pastels, Graphics and Printmaking, Oil and Acrylic, Watercolor, Mixed Media, Ceramics, Glass, Sculpture, Fibers, Wood, Jewelry and Metal, Photography.

**The artist must be present for the entire day of the festival and will be responsible for the sale of her/his work.** No agents, dealers or merchants are permitted.

**All work exhibited must be created by the entrant. Absolutely no prints (including notecards, calendars or other small reproductions), other than hand-pulled art prints (serigraphs, etchings, etc. printed by the artist) will be accepted. No mechanically reproduced prints will be accepted. No giclee prints will be accepted.**

**Each work exhibited at the Festival must be clearly labeled with the price.** There are no commissions charged by the Community Arts Center on any sales.

**Unacceptable items include:** imported work of any type, work created by a person other than the artist, greenware pottery, sculpture from molds, hand-crafts, mass produced factory art, reproductions on notecards or postcards as well as any other items deemed by the committee to not fall within the spirit of our requirements. Artists may NOT display OR sell these items at the Community Arts Center's Fine Arts and Crafts Festival.

#### Applicants must submit the following for consideration of the jury:

-a CD with digital files for viewing in jpg format at a minimum of 72 dpi saved to highest level, with the longest dimension being 900 pixels. Please label each file with last name, first initial, and number corresponding to the entry number on your form. (e.g. SmithJ1) If digital files are submitted, please identify images on the entry form with the title of the work.

**Applicants MUST include a self-addressed, stamped envelope with their application** for the return of application materials and the jury's decision. No entry materials will be returned without a SASE.

**Exhibitors will be permitted to exhibit only the specific type of work submitted to the jury.** If entering in more than one category, please submit separate applications. *As an example, jewelry cannot be exhibited with another medium unless approved by the jury.*

**A non-refundable jury fee of \$20 is required and must be submitted with the properly completed application and the required slides/photos. In addition, applicants should include a check for space rental (\$100 for CAC members/ \$110 for non-members).**

**Selected exhibitors will be assigned a 10' X 10' space on State Street or Veteran's Square in Media, PA.** Each exhibitor must bring everything needed for display.

*The Community Arts Center will return the booth fee checks of any applicant NOT accepted to exhibit in the Festival. Materials of selected exhibitors will be returned the day of the festival. Each selected exhibitor will receive festival invitations to distribute.*

**Completed applications must be received by the Community Arts Center no later than June 15, 2011.** Artists will be notified of the jury's decision by July 1, 2010. If an exhibitor must cancel, 50% of the exhibition fee will be refunded prior to August 1, 2011. There will be no refunds for cancellations after August 1, 2011.
